Join the City of Roseville for an open house to learn about proposed traffic improvements for the Atlantic and Vernon Street 'S-curve' area.

Stop by the Civic Center between 5 and 6:30 p.m. on June 29 and learn about what's planned, ask questions, and talk with the project team.

Improvements are anticipated to calm traffic, lower speeds, and reduce collisions. Low volume left-hand turning restrictions are included as part of the project. Enhanced lighted pedestrian crossings, lane reductions, beautification and landscaped medians are also planned.

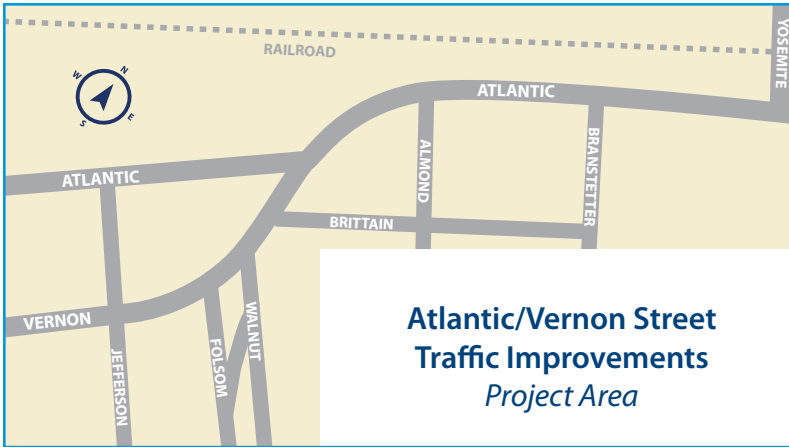
